standards. If installation is not installed in a worknounlike manner, Pacific, at no expense to the Homeowners, will cause any deficiencies to be

If upon completion of installation, Homcovners believe the work is deficient, Homeowners must contact the Manufer. Weatherization Services Department, Pacific Power & Light Company, Public Building, 920 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97204, (503) 243-1122, or the District Manager at their local Pacific Power & Light Company district office.

EXCEPT FOR THE WARRANTIES EXPESSLY DESCRIBED IN THIS AGREEMENT, PACIFIC MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, ALL EXPRESS AND IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARE EXTENDED ONLY TO AND LIMITED TO THE HOMEDWNERS, WILL START UPON COMPLITION OF THE INSTALLATION OF THE INSULATION, AND WILL TERMINATE 90 DAYS FROM THAT DATE, HOMEOWNERS REMEDIES FOR ANY CLAIM, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR CONTRACT, ARE LIMITED TO THOSE REMEDIES EX. OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR CONTRACT ARE LIMITED TO THOSE REMEDIES EX-PRESSLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL PACIFIC BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CON-SEQUENTIAL DAMAGES TO HOMEOWNERS OR ANYONE ELSE.

Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusion may not apply to This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Pacific conducts Home Energy Analyses at the repest of its customers to determine the cost-effectiveness of insulation and weatherization based upon average consumption patterns and typical local veather conditions. However, because of the variability and uniqueness of individual energy use, it is not possible to precisely predict the savings that will accrue to any particular individual. Therefore, Pacific, by providing information in good faith concerning the anticipated benefits of insulation and weatherization, or by entering into this agreement, does not warrant that the installation of the insulation and weatherization materials provided for in this agreement will result in savings of money or electrical consumption.

# 4. HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO REPAY W.O. # 01059

Individual Homeowners (natural persons) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any let all or equitable interest in any part of the property. Homeowners other than natural persons feorporations, trusts, etc. I shall pay to Pacific, withour interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization within seven years of the date of this agreement. Homeowners may pay such coal to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

#### 5. HOMEOWNERS' OBLACATION TO NOTH Y

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property, whether it is voluntary or involuntary. Such notice shall be sent as soon as Homeowners know that there will be a sale or transfer for consideration, and not later than one week before the expected sale or transfer. The nonce must include the name of the Homeowners, the address of the property, the name of the person to whom the property is being sold or transferred, and the name of any person or company who is acting as a closing agent for the sale or transfer or is otherwise participating in the transaction. Homeowners authorized Pacific to contact any of the persons so named and authorize and direct such persons to pay Pacific any obligations owing under this agreement from any monies which such persons owe to Homeowners

### 6. SECURITY INTEREST

To secure the Homeowners' obligations herein. Homeowners hereby mortgage to Pacific the property, together with all present and future appartenances, agreewements, and fixtures thereto. This paragraph shall not take effect until that date which is one day prior to the earliest to occur

  (3) the date on which any action or suit is filed to foreclose or recover on the property or any part thereof for any mortgage, lien, judgment or other encumbrance on the property or any part thereof which existed prior to the recording date of this agreement. 7. PERFECTION OF SECURITY INTEREST

Pacific may record this agreement in the county real property records, and Homeowners shall execute any other documents deemed necessary by Pacific to perfect this security interest.
