Pacific warrants that the insulation and weatherization materia's will be installed in a workmanlike manner consistent with prevailing industry stardards. If installation is not installed in a workmanlike manage, Pacific, at no expense to the Homeowners, will cause any deficiencies to be

Corrected.

H upon completion of installation, Homeowners believe the work is deficient; Homeowners must contact the Manager, Weatherization Services Department, Pacific Power & Light Company, Public 3 ddirect, 920 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97204, (503) 243-1122, or the District Manager at their local Pacific Power & Light Company obstrict office.

Homeowners other than natural persons prior to the sciency transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Homeowners other than natural persons (corporations, transfer etc.) shall pay to Pacific, without interest; the actual contract cost of the insulation and scentherization within seven years of the late of this agreement. Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Such notice shall be sent as soon as Homeowners know that there will be a sale or transfer for consideration, and not later than one week before the expected sale or transfer. The notice must include the name of the Homeowners, the address of the property, the name of the person to whom the property is being sold or transferred, and the name of any person or company who is acting as a property of the sale or transfer or is otherwise participating in the transaction. Homeowners authorized Pacific to contact any of the persons closing agent for the sale or transfer or is otherwise participating in the transaction. ### 6. SECURITY INTEREST

(1) the date on which any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property is transferred;

- (2) the date on which any legal or equirable interest in any part of the property which does not exist as of the date of this agreement is created, including without limitation any deed, lien, mortgage, judgment or land sale contract;
- (3) the date on which any action or soft is filed to foreclose or recover on the property or any part thereof for any mortgage, lien, judgment or other encumbrance on the property or any part thereof which existed prior to the recording date of this agreement.

## 7. PERFECTION OF SECURITY INTEREST

Pacific may record this agreement in the county real property records, and Homeowners shall execute any other documents deemed necessary by Pacific to perfect this security interest.

- 8. Each Homeowner who signs this agreement shall be individually and jointly responsible for performing the obligations of Homeowners in this agreement. This agreement shall be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties. Homeowners shall not assign this agreement without the written consent of Pacific.
- 9. This document contains the entire agreement between the porties and shall not be modified except by a written instrument signed by the

## 10. HOMEOWNERS' RIGHT TO CANCEL (OREGON STATUTE)

If this agreement was solicited at a place other than the offices of Pacific, and you do not want the goods or services, you may cancel this agreement without any penalty, cancellation fee or other financial obligation by mailing a notice to Pacific. The notice must say that you do not want the goods or services and must be mailed before 12:00 midnight of the third business day after you sign this agreement. (2) In the case of goods, the goods cannot be returned to Pacific in substantially as good condition as when received by Homeowners.
