Ceiling Insulation: Install insulation from an estimated existing R- 19 to an estimated R- 38 approximately 1364 sq. ft. Flor Insulation: Install insulation from an estimated existing R- 0 to an estimated R- 19 approximately 1364 sq. ft.

Duct Insulation: Install duct insulation to an estimated R

Moisture Barrier: Install moisture barrier in crawl space. Wrap water pipes, 2 gable vents, 4 roof vents.

The cost of the astallation described above, for which Homeowaers will ultimately be responsible under this agreement, is \$2,597.00

Pacific shall contract with an independent insulation at d weatherization contractor and will pay for work done as described above. Pacific wirrants that the insulation and weatherization naterials will be installed in a workmanlike manner consistent with prevailing industry racing warrants that the insulation and weatherization, nauthals will be instanged in a workmanike manner consistent with prevaining manual standards. If installation is not installed in a workmanlike manner, Pacific, at no expense to the Homeowners, will cause any deficiencies to be

Homeowners may pay such cos to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the rale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. whether it is voluntary or involuntary. Such notice shall be sent as soon as Homeowners know that there will be a sale or transfer for consideration, and not later than one week before the expected sale or transfer. The notice must include the name of the Homeowners, the address of the non, and not mer than one week before the expense sale of transfer, the conce must meanle the name of the person to whom the property is being sold or transferred, and the name of any person or company who is acting as a property, the name of the person to smoot the property is being some of transaction.
