5. The notice must include the name of the Homeowners, the address of the property, the name of the person to whom the property is being sold or transferred, and the name of any person or company who is acting as closing agent for the sale or transfer or is thervise participating in the transaction. Homeowners authorized Pacific to contact any of the persons owe to Homeowners.

8. Each Homeowner who signs this agreement shall be individually and jointly responsible for performing the obligations of Homeowners in this

agreement. This agreement shall be bit ding upon the successors and assigns of the parties. Homeowners shall not assign this agreement without the
