If installation is not installed in a workmanlike manner, Pacific, at no expense to the Homeowners, will cause any deficiencies to be If upon completion of installation, Homeowners believe the work is deficient, Homeowners must contact the Manager, Weatherization Services Department, Pacific Power & Light Company, Public Building, 920 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97204, (503) 243-1122, or the Services Department, Pacific Power & Light Company, Public Building, 920 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon 9(204, 1303) 243-1122, or the District Manager at their local Pacific Power & Light Company district office. EXCEPT FOR THE WARRANTIES EXPRESSLY DESCRIBED IN THIS AGREEMENT, PACIFIC MAKES NO OTHER WARRAINTIES. ALL EXPRESS AND IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARE EXTENDED ONLY TO AND LIMITED TO THE HOMEOWNERS, WILL START UPON COMPLETION OF THE INSTALLATION OF THE INSULATION, AND WILL TERMINATE ON DAYS FROM THAT DATE. HOMEOWNERS' REMEDIES FOR ANY CLAIM UNCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO EXPRESS HOMEOWNERS, WILL START UPON COMPLETION OF THE INSTALLATION OF THE INSULATION, AND WILL LERMINATE 90 DAYS FROM THAT DATE. HOMEOWNERS' REMEDIES FOR ANY CLAIM, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, NEXTLEGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR CONTRACT ARE LIMITED TO THOSE REMEDIES EX-PRESSLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL PACIFIC BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CON-NOTE: Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitation may not apply to you. Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. whether it is voluntary or involuntary. Such notice shall be sent as soon as Homeowners know that there will be a sale or transfer for consideration, and not later than one week before the expected sale or transfer. The notice must include the name of the Homeowners, the address of the tion, and not later than one week belows the expected sale of transfer. The notice must include the name of the formeowners, the address of the property, the name of the person to whom the property is being sold or transferred, and the name of any person or company who is acting as a closing agent for the sale or transfer or is otherwise participating in the transaction.
