This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Pacific conducts Home Energy Analyses at the request of its customers to determine the cost-effectiveness of insulation and weatherization based upon average consumption patterns and typical local weather conditions. However, because of the variability and uniqueness of individual energy use, it is not possible to precisely predict the savings that will accrue to any particular individual. Therefore, Pacific, by providing information in good faith concerning the anticipated benefits of insulation and weatherination, or by entering into this agreement, does not warrant that the installation of the insulation and weatherization materials provided for in this agreement will result in savings of money or electrical consumption.

4. HOMEOWNERS OBLIGATION TO REPAY W.O. H 0/037

Individual Homeowners (natural persons) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Homeowners other than natural persons (corporations, trusts, etc.) shall pay to Paci ic, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization within seven years of the date of this agreement. Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

5. HOMEOWNERS OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. whether it is voluntary or involuntary. Such notice shall be sent as soon as Homeowners know that there will be a sale or transfer for consideration, and not later than one week before the expected sale or transfer. The notice must include the name of the Homeowners, the address of the property, the name of the person to whom the property is being sold or transferred, and the name of any person or company who is acting as a closing agent for the sale or transfer or is otherwise participating in the transaction. Homeowners authorized Pacific to contact any of the persons so named and authorize and direct such a rsons to pay Pacific any obligations owing under this agreement from any monies which such persons

6. SECURITY INTEREST

To secure the Homeowners' obligations herein. Homeowners hereby mortgage to Pacific the property, together with all present and future appurtenances, improvements, and fixtures thereto. This paragraph shall not take effect until that date which is one day prior to the earliest to occur scapheogrammatilibresidal asteroker of the following dates:

(1) the date on which any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property is transferred;

(2) the date on which any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property which does not exist as of the date of this agreement is created.

including without limitation any deed, lien, mortgage, judgment or land sale contract;

(3) the date on which any action or suit is filed to foreclose or recover on the property or any part thereof for any mortgage, lien, judgment or other encumbrance on the property or any part thereof which existed prior to the recording date of this agreement.

7. PERFECTION OF SECURITY INTEREST

Pacific may record this agreement in the county real property records, and Homeowners shall execute any other documents deemed necessary by Pacific to perfect this security interest.

- 8. Each Homeowner who signs this agrament shall be individually and jointly responsible for performing the obligations of Homeowners in this agreement. This agreement shall be binding t pon the successors and a ssigns of the parties. Homeowners shall not assign this agreement without the written consent of Pacific.
- 9. This document contains the entire agreement between the parties and shall not be modified except by a written instrument signed by the parties.

10. HOMEOWNERS' RIGHT TO CANCEL. (OREGON STATUTE)

If this agreement was solicited at a place other than the offices of Pacific, and you do not want the goods or services, you may cancel this agreement without any penalty, cancellation ee or other financial obligation by mailing a notice to Pacific. The notice must say that you do not want the goods or services and must be mailed before 12:00 midnight of the third business day after you sign this agreement. The notice must be mailed to: Pacific Power & Light Company, P.O. Box 728 Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601

However: You may not cancel if you have requested Pacific to provide goods or services without delay because of an emergency and

(1) Pacific in good faith makes a substartial beginning of performance of the contract before you give notice of cancellation, and

(2) In the case of goods, the goods cannot be returned to Pacific in substantially as good condition as when received by Homeowners.

HOMEOWNER'S RIGHT TO CANCEL. (FEDERAL STATUTE). You, the Homeowner, may cancel this transaction at any time prior to midnight of the third business day after the date of this transaction. See the attached notice of cancellation form for an explanation of this right.
