Klamath County Planning Findings of Fact and Order

7 A hearing was held in this matter on March 18, 1982, which was continued to April 15, 1982, pursuant to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 45, Klamath County, before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The applicant was present. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Jonathan Chudnoff. The Hearings Reporter was Barbara Thomson.

Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the applicant. There were several persons who testified both for and against this proposed Conditional Use Permit requested by the applicant.

Resources Department The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Findings of Fact: 4

- 1. The site is not adequate in size and shape to house FINDINGS OF FACT: 7 the proposed activity, due to its close proximity to the sewage 8 treatment lagoons which are within 200 feet from the site at some points. The site will not fit in with the surrounding area 10 | because the applicant's planned activities necessitate periodic 11 | blasting, and this is not compatible with the close proximity of 12 the above mentioned sewage treatment lagoons, which lagoons are 13 not sealed. Also, there are several residences within close proximity of the site which could be adversely affected if the sewage treatment lagoons were damaged.
  - 2. The site has adequate access to streets and highways 17 to carry the proposed traffic flow which would be generated by the proposed use. 18
  - 3. The applicant failed to prove that the necessary 20 | blasting at the site will not adversely effect the nearby sewage treatment lagoons. Testimony from Mr. O'Neil, a proponent for the applicant, was that no one can answer the question of whether or not the necessary blasting will be detrimental to the sewage treatment lagoons. In addition, there was testimony from Mrs. Gorham, chairman of the area committee in question, that at their 24 meeting the applicant had a blasting expert present and he testi-25 fied that although safety measurescould be taken there was no guarantee the blasting would not adversely effect the sewage C.U.P. 8-82 Page -2-

treatment lagoons. 4. The granting of this permit would violate the following L. C. D. C. Goals: A. Goal No. 2 - Land Use Planning - The proximity of the 3 residences, the sewage treatment lagoons, and the proposed site 4 are not compatible with good planning. As set forth in Numbers 5 1 and 3 above, the necessary blasting at the site is not compatible 6 with the existing residential, agricultural, and sewage treatment 7 uses of this land. B. Goal No. 10 - Housing - This goal would be violated 9 10 due to the facts set forth in Goal No. 2 above. The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of 11 12 Fact, accordingly orders as follows: 13 That real property described as the 14 "parcel of land generally located at Gray's Ridge, Klamath Hills, east of Lower Lake Road 15 approximately 1 1/8 miles south of Cross Road, and more particularly described as the E% of 16 the NE% of Section 17, Township 40, Range 9, being Tax Lot 117-1, Klamath County, Oregon" 17 is hereby denied a Conditional Use Permit in accordance with 18 the terms of the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 45, and, 19 20 henceforth, will not be allowed a rock quarry in the AU-5 21 (Agricultural Use - Five Acres) zone. 22 Entered at Klamath Falls, Oregon, this May of 23 24 april 1982. 25 26 KLAMATH COUNTY HEARINGS DIVISION 27 28 C.U.P. 8-82
