Findings of Fact and Order

A hearing was held on this matter on July 1, 1982, pursuant to netice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 45, Klamath County, before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The applicant was present. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Jonathan Chudnoff. The Hearings Reporter was Barbara Thomson.

Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the applicant. There were adjacent property owners present who stated they had no objections to the proposed Conditional Use Permit requested by the applicant.

The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Findings of Fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. The site is adequate in size and shape to house the proposed activity, and said activity will fit in with the surrounding neighborhood, so long as the conditions set forth hereinbelow are followed.

 2. The site has adequate access to streets and highways to carry the traffic flow which will be generated by the proposed use.

- 3. There was no evidence presented in opposition to this application and there will be no adverse effect on the abutting property owners so long as the conditions set forth hereinbelow are followed.
- 4. The granting of this conditional use permit is consistent with the golas of the L.C.D.C.
- 5. This conditional use permit is granted subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS:

- a. Applicant shall not erect more than two signs with regard to this home occupation and said signs shall not be larger than 3' x 3', and they shall be erected so as to fit in with the surrounding area.
- b. The applicant's home occupation shall operate only during the hous from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- c. No person shall work for applicant in regard to this home occupation other than the applicant, his wife, and any of his children.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as the

"parcel of land generally located southwest of the junction of Falvey Road and Court Drive, at the west end of the City of Merrill, and more particularly described as being Lots 19, 20, 21, of Lost River Court Addition, being Tax Lots 21 and 22, NW½ NE¾, Section 11, Township 41, Range 10, Klamath County, Oregon."
