A hearing was held on this matter on July 1, 1982 pursuant to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 45, Klamath County, before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. FINDINGS OF FACT:

The site is adequate in size and shape to house the proposed activity, and said activity will fit in with the surrounding neighborhood.

- 2. The site has adequate access to streets and highways to carry the traffic flow which will be generated by this proposed use.
- There was no evidence presented in opposition to this application and there will be no adverse effect on abutting property owners.
- 4. The granting of this conditional use permit is consistent with the goals of the L.C.D.C.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as the

"parcel of land generally located south of First Street, behind the Wheel Cafe in Chemult, and more particularly described as being Tax Lot 3900 located in the NW4 SE4 of Section 21, Township 27, Range 8, Klamath County, Oregon."

is hereby granted a Conditional Use Permit in accordance with the terms of the Klamath County Zoning Ordinacne No. 45, and, henceforth, will be allowed a community recreation facility in the RCR (Rural Community Residential) zone.
