KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That JAMES E. TONEY and LINDA M. TONEY, husband and wife, hereinafter called the grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated, to grantor paid by DALE A. DAVIS and RUTH M. DAVIS, husband and wife, the grantee, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of KLAMATH and State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 29, Block 2, ROLLING HILLS SUBDIVISION, TRACT NO. 1099, according to the official plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of Klamath County, Oregon.

SUBJECT TO:

1. Restrictions and easements as contained in plat dedication.
