Klamath County Planning Findings of Fact and Order

A hearing was held on this matter on May 25, 1982 pursuant
to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 45, Klamath
County, before the Klamath County Planning Commission. Testimony
and information produced at the hearing by the applicant, Planning
Staff and others in attendance became part of the record. The
hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence submitted
at the hearing, the Planning Commission made the following
Findings of Fact:

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FINDINGS OF FACT:

The Planning Commission found there are exceptional
 and extraordinary circumstances which apply in that, by granting
 the Variance in height for distribution shafts and elevator,
 this would allow the flow of malt and grain by gravity which
 would reduce costs of the Malt House.

2. The Planning Commission also found per testimony from
 applicant that by allowing the height Variance, applicant would
 not have to change the design of the Malt House, therefore
 reducing both energy and costs.

3. The Planning Commission found no one testified in
opposition to the granting of the Variance and testimony indicated
that there wouldn't be any detrimental effect to the public health,
safety or welfare or any detrimental effect to any abutting
property owners.

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1	4. The Planning Commission found the requested Variance
2	is the minimum Variance which will alleviate a hardship, due to
3	the placement of the grain bins and Malt House.
4	5. The Planning Commission found the requested Variance
5	is consistent with the relevant policies of the LCDC Goals of the
6	Comprehensive Plan.
7	The Planning Commission, based on the foregoing Findings
8	of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:
9	That real property described as
10	That parcel of land generally located approximately two miles northeast of Olene Store and approximately
11	seven miles east of Klamath Falls' Lakeview Junction
12	and west side of the OC&E Railroad, and more particularly described as NE ½ of Section 14,
13	Township 39, Range 10, portion of Tax Lot 100, Klamath County, Oregon.
14	is hereby granted a Variance to reduce heigth limitation from
15	150' to 215', a difference of 65' for the purpose of constructing
16	a Malt House.
