In the latter event the beneficiary or the trustee shot execute and cause to be recorded his written notice of default and his election to sell the said described real property to satisty the obligations secured hereby, whereupon the trustee shall like them and place of sale, give notice thereof as then required by law and proceed to foreclose this trust deed in the manner provided in ORS 66.740 to 86.795.

13. Trustee shall deliver to the purchaser its deed in form as required by law conveying the property so sold, but without any coverant or warranty, express or implied.
