

The Applicant will pay to the Cooperative the sum of \$_ which constitutes the Applicant's deposit. The Applicant will, as electric energy is available, purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the premises described below, and will pay, therefore, monthly in accordance with the current applicable rate schedule in accordance with the rules and regulations established by the Board of Directors of the Cooperative. The Applicant, by paying a deposit fee, assumes no personal liability or responsibility for any debts or liabilities of the Cooperative 5. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by such rules and regulations as may be established by the Board of Directors from time to time. 6. Additional charges will be made for underground services: 354 per for wire or a. This agreement is subject to the execution of all easements necessary to serve the subject property.
