O R D E R

This Tract, being Tract No. 1214, named Deschutes Land Sales Unit No. 2, came on for hearing before the Board of County Commissioners of appeal of recommendations as set forth by the Board of County Commissioners, with public hearing having been heard on August 16, 1982, wherefrom the applicant, Planning Department Staff and other persons in attendance, the Board of County Commissioners denied applicant's appeal to remove two recommendations of final plat approval, those recommendations being One (1), the requirement of submitting a written hydrology report, and Two (2), to be annexed into a fire district.

The Board of County Commissioners original order dated February 10, 1981, still stands as is with no changes to the two recommendations that were requested to be waived by John Schoonover.

Those recommendations being:

1. If a central water supply system is not to be provided, the subdivider must submit a written hydrology report documenting the availability of water and the general history of wells in the area. This document must be prepared by a registered engineer.

2. Tract to be annexed into a fire district for fire protection.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the two described recommendations above still stand as is of Tract 1214 with the
