


TRUST DEED RECONVEYANCE

IN KLAMATH COUNTRY, OREGON

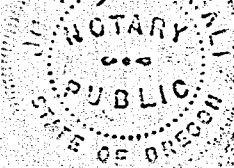


