of signing sales agreement.

In order to comply with M.R.S.A. Title 18-A §5-501, this power of attorney shall not be affected by the future disability of the principal. If the principal becomes disabled, this power of attorney shall continue in full force and effect until death.

and the same again at pleasure to revoke. And generally to say, do, act, transact, determine, accomplish and

finish all matters and things whatsoever, relating to the premises as fully, amply and effectually, to all intents

and purposes, as I the said constituent, if present, ought or might personally, although the matter

should require more special authority than is hereby comprised I the said constituent ratifying, allowing

and holding firm and valid, all and whatsoever my said Attorney or my substitutes shall law-

fully do, or cause to be done, in and about the premises, by virtue of these presents.

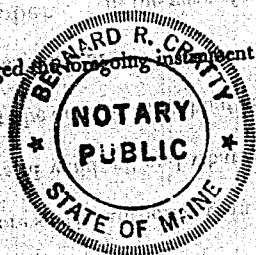
