ORDER

THIS MATTER having come on for hearing upon the application of Tottsie Lorenz for a Conditional Use Permit for homesite on resource land per Ordinance 48 on real property described as a portion of Section 4, and a portion of Tax Lot 1410, Township 36, Range 14. Public hearing having been heard by the Klamath County Planning Commission on June 22, 1982, wherefrom the testimony and information produced at the hearing by the applicant, Planning Staff and others in attendance, the Planning Commission recommended approval. Following action by the Planning Commission, a public hearing before the Board of Commissioners was held on August 23, 1982, wherefrom the testimony at said hearing it appeared that the record below was accurate and complete at the hearing before the Planning Commission and that the application should be granted.

The Board of Commissioners makes the following Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The Board of Commissioners finds the applicant to be Tottsie Lorenz.
- 2. The Board of Commissioners finds that the general location of site is approximately one and one fourth miles north of Campbell Road and two miles east of its junction with Camp Six Road.
- 3. The Board of Commissioners finds that the size of property involved for change in land use is approximately five

acres and rectangular in shape.

- 4. The Board of Commissioners finds that the ground is 3 rolling to flat, with sagebrush, juniper and scattered pine making up the vegetation.
 - The Board of Commissioners finds, based on testimony given, that site is not suitable for raising forest products in any economical fashion and site does not have commercial forest species on site as of now.
 - 6. The Board of Commissioners found site for Conditional Use Permit would be for a homesite in a rural setting to provide a residence for person employed in agriculture.
 - The Board of Commissioners find that per testimony, 7. that access would be off of an easement off of Campbell Road, a county road. This road is gravelled and appears to be able to carry the kind of traffic that would be generated by proposed use.
 - The Board of Commissioners find, per testimony, that the effect on adjacent and surrounding properties would be minimal to none in that it does not adversely effect agriculture or forestry uses.
 - 9. The Board of Commissioners found, per testimony, that Department of Environmental Quality approval for septics would be necessary prior to the installation of septic systems.
 - The Board of Commissioners find that Conditional Use Permit would not have an adverse effect on wildlife on Goal 5 elements.
 - The Board of Commissioners found notification had been 11. sent to all those of ocncern.

12. The Board of Commissioners found site to be predomin antly Class IV soils. Residence would now be in conjunction with agricultural uses since it is for a person who would be employed on the ranch.

- 13. The Board of Commissioners found site to have no Timber Site Productivity Rating and no potential for commercial timber production.
- 14. The Board of Commissioners found site for change in use not being in a historic area or having significant natural resources.
- 15. The Board of Commissioners found a portion of the site to be located in a flood hazard area; however, residence will not be constructed in flood plain.
- 16. The Board of Commissioners found that the site did not have facilities such as electricity and telephones but is within the Bly School District.
- 17. The Board of Commissioners found per testimony that it was not necessary that this residence be served with electrical and telephone facilities. The primitive homesite would be used for a person employed by the surrounding ranch.
- 18. The Board of Commissioners found per testimony that the proposed dwelling would be in conjunction with farm use although the Conditional Use Permit was necessary under Ordinance 48 in order to partition the property.
- 19. The Board of Commissioners found per testimony that the proposed dwelling was compatible with farm use, consistent with the intent of the agricultural zone, would not interfere with accepted farming practices on adjacent land, and would not alter CUP 23-82 Page -3-

the overall land use pattern of the area, and would lie situated on generally unsuitable land for the production of farm crops and livestock when considering the drainage and flooding of the area, the sparse vegetation and the small size of the tract.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:
