Sampson, Angela Sampson, and Angela B. Sampson, deceased, having filed herein his verified petition for preliminary distribution and the petition coming on for hearing this day the Court finds:

Due and legal notice of the hearing of the petition has been regularly given for the period and in the manner provided by law.

All allegations of the petition are true and the petition should be approved.

1 Notice to Creditors has been duly given, published, and
2 filed, and an affidavit showing due publication of notice was filed
3 with the clerk of this court on July 9, 1979.

4 More than two months have elapsed since the issuance of
5 letters testamentary in this estate and since the first publication
6 of notice to creditors.

7 All claims filed or presented to date against the estate
8 have been allowed by petitioner, approved by this Court, and paid.
9 All known debts of decedent and of the estate and all incurred
10 expenses of administration, except attorney's fees and executor's
11 commissions have been paid.

12 The estate is but little indebted.

13 The California inheritance tax payable in this estate has
14 not yet been determined, but \$730.00 estimated to be the full
15 amount of inheritance taxes due has been paid and receipt of the
16 County Treasurer therefor is on file herein. The written consent
17 of the State Inheritance Tax Attorney has been given to the
18 distribution hereinafter made. A federal estate tax return has
19 been filed showing no tax due. The return remains subject to audit.

20 Although the estate is not now in a condition to be



I, ANGELA BASSETT SAMPSON, residing in San Francisco, California, make this will, revoking all prior wills and codicils.

FIRST:
