In the latter event the beneficiary or the trustee shall execute and cause to be recorded his written notice of default and his election to self the said described real property to satisfy the obligations secured hereby, whereupon the trustee shall fix the time and place of sale, give notice thereof as then required by law and proceed to foreclose this trust deed in the manner provided in ORS 86.740 to 86.795.
