9 THIS MATTER coming on regularly for hearing on the  
10 1st day of December, 1981, and Petitioner appearing in person  
11 and with her attorney, Verden L. Hockett, Jr., P.C., and  
Respondent appearing not, and

12 It appearing to the Court that a good faith effort  
13 was made to serve Respondent with Summons and Complaint, to-wit:

14 On March 2, 1981, a Petition to Dissolve Marriage was  
15 filed in the above court. Petitioner informed her attorney that  
16 Respondent was working on Kodiak Island, Alaska. The said  
Petition with Summons was then sent to a private process server  
on March 12, 1981. There was no further action from the process  
server, in spite of two letters sent to him, requesting notification  
of his progress.

17 On July 6, 1981, said Petition and Summons was sent to  
18 the Alaska State Troopers to attempt service on Respondent. On  
19 August 5, 1981, said Troopers called Petitioner's attorney and  
20 informed him that Respondent was "up north" somewhere gold mining.  
21 On August 24, 1981, said Petition and Summons was returned to  
this office. The Alaska State Troopers had been informed by  
Respondent's former employer that Respondent had not been working  
there since August 4, 1981, and that Respondent would not be  
returning to work with them.

22 On September 24, 1981, an Order was entered by the  
23 above court, allowing service on Respondent by mailing and pub-  
24 lication. That on October 6, 1981, Petitioner phoned this office  
25 and informed her attorney that Respondent had called her and told  
26 her he was residing in Springfield. On October 9, 1981, said  
Summons and Petition was sent to Respondent at the address given  
to Petitioner, by certified mail. On October 12, 1981, said  
Summons and Petition was sent to the News-Review, Roseburg, Oregon  
for publication.

On October 27, 1981, said letter containing Summons and Petition was returned to this office, unclaimed by Respondent. On November 4, 1981, publication of said Summons and Petition was finished, and an Affidavit of Publication was submitted to the Court, along with an Affidavit of Mailing, on November 17, 1981.

It further appearing to the Court that the 90 day waiting period having expired; that Respondent is not in the military or naval service of the United States; and that an Order of Default has heretofore been duly entered against the Respondent for his failure to appear, answer or plead herein within the time required and prescribed by statute therefor; and

The Court finding that Petitioner was and is a bona fide resident and inhabitant of the State of Oregon, and has been so for more than six months immediately prior to the commencement of this suit for Dissolution of Marriage, and that irreconcilable differences exist between the parties making continuation of the marriage relationship impossible, and that the parties were married on December 31, 1976, in Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon and that no children were born of the marriage, and;

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that Petitioner SHEILA NANN PEETSCH is 30 years old and her address is 779 Wheeler Canyon Road, Oakland, Oregon, and she holds Social Security Account No. 540-62-2782; that Respondent GEORGE WILLIAM PEETSCH is 43 years old and his address is unknown, and that he holds Social Security Account No. unknown.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. The marriage of the parties is hereby dissolved and said dissolution is finally effective March 6, 1982.

2. The property of the parties and its appropriate disposition by this Court are attached hereto as Amended Exhibit "A" and by this reference incorporated herein.


