given on December 2, 1982 at the Hearing are hereby incorporated into the record in their entirety. 2 3

- 2. The applicant has requested an amendment to the condition regarding the hours of the participants' sports requesting that the condition be amended so that participants' sports use of the facility may be available from dawn to dusk, sunrise to sunset, seven (7) days per week.
- 8 The applicant advised that this request is necessary in order to allow for the beneficial use of the facility for 9 the members of the public. 10 11
- 4. Additionally, evidence was submitted that the Order should be clarified as to indicate the use of the camping 12 grounds for overnight camping and that the hours for the operation of the campgrounds would be separate from those of the participants' sports facility.

KLAMATH COUNTY DEVELOPMENT CODE CRITERIA:

- Klamath County Development Code Section 44.003 sets forth the general criteria for consideration in the application for a conditional use permit:
- That the use is conditionally permitted in the zone in which it is proposed.
- That the location, size, design and operating В. characteristics of the proposed uses is in conformance with the Klamath County Comprehensive Plan.
- That the location, size, design and operating C. characteristics of the proposed development will be compatible

with, and will not adversely effect, the livability or appropriate development of abutting properties in the surrounding neighborhood. Consideration shall be given to the harmony in scale, bulk, coverage and density; to the availability of civic facilities, and utilities; to harmful effects, if any, upon desirable neighborhood character; to the generation of traffic and the capacity of surrounding streets and to other relevant impact of the development.

D. That the location, size, and site planning of the proposed development will provide a convenient and functional living, working, shopping, or civic environment, and will be as attractive as the nature of the use and its location in this setting warrant.

- 2. The Klamath County Code Section 44.001 sets forth the general purpose of Article 44, Conditional Use Permit, as follows: The purpose of the Conditional Use Permit is to provide a mechanism whereby uses which may be suitable only in certain locations or only if designed or operated in a particular manner may be allowed within the basic zone designation.
- 3. ORS 197.175 requires all zoning and related ordinances adopted by the County be in conformance with the State-Wide Planning Goals.
- 4. Section 51.021 in Klamath County Development Code provides in Section C, 1 and 2, for the development of civic use types and participant sports use types. These sections as broadly construed would include all the activities proposed by

The campgrounds facilities, once established, will be overnight facilities requiring hours in addition to those provided for the participants' sports facility.
