6	This Comprehensive Land Use Plan Map Change and Zone
7	Change No. 1-83 for James Motley, came on for hearing before the
8	Klamath County Planning Commission with public hearing having
9	been heard on March 22, 1983, wherefrom the testimony, reports
10	and information produced at the hearing by the applicant,
11	planning staff and other persons in attendance, the Planning
12	Commission denied the CLUP and Zone Change request from High
13	Density Residential to General Commercial to allow mini-storage
14	units.
15	The Planning Commission makes the following Findings of
16	Fact:
17	FINDINGS OF FACT:
18	1. The Planning Commission finds the applicant who made
19	the request to be James Motley.
20	2. Property for change in Comprehensive Land Use Plan
21	and Zone was located in the NW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 39,
22	Range 9, being Tax Lot 4500.
23	3. The parcel for change was rectangular in shape and
24	approximately 22,470 square feet in size.
25	4. Testimony indicated that the parcel for change in
26	land use and zone had drainage problems due to no drainage system
27	off of the property.
28	5. It was pointed out to the Planning Commission from

testimony that in the surrounding area that there were other 1 mini-storage warehouse units and the need for additional storage 2 units was not necessary. 3

4 It was pointed out to the Planning Commission that 6. this was an area that had been planned and zoned for multiple 5 uses since 1972, and that there had been other land use changes 6 7 approved in the area for multiple use, therefore indicating that the trend was towards multiple density and not that of commercial. 8

9 7. By allowing this change to be approved, the change would deplete the area of high density as planned and approved 10 by the Planning Commission and Board of County Commissioners on 11 12 December 21, 1982.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

14 The Planning Commission concludes that this change 1. in Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone would not permit orderly 15 and beneficial development, and would not protect the character 16 of the neighborhood. 17

The Planning Commission concludes that this request 2. 19 for change would not further the goals and policies of the Klamath County Comprehensive Land Use Plan as adopted by the 20 Board of Commissioners on December 21, 1982. 21 22

Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that the application 23 for the Comprehensive Land Use Plan Change from Urban Density 24 to General Commercial and a zone change from RH (High Density Residential) to CG (General Commercial) for James Motley is to 25 26 be denied.
