Pacific warrants that the insulation and weatherization materials will be installed in a workmanlike manner consistent with prevailing industry standards. If installation is not installed in a workmanlike manner, Pacific, at no expense to the Homeowners, will cause any deficiencies to be

Corrected.

If upon completion of installation, Homeowners believe the work is deficient, Homeowners must contact the Manager, Weatherization Services Department, Pacific Power & Light Company, Public Building, 920 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97204, (503) 243-1122, or the District Manager at their local Pacific Power & Light Company district office.

EXCEPT FOR THE WARRANTIES EXPRESSLY DESCRIBED IN THIS AGREEMENT, PACIFIC MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, ALL EXPRESS AND IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARE EXTENDED ONLY TO AND LIMITED TO THE HOMEOWNERS, WILL START UPON COMPLETION OF THE INSTALLATION OF THE INSULATION, AND WILL TERMINATE OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR CONTRACT ARE LIMITED TO LIMITED TO EXPRESS PRESSLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL PACIFIC BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES TO HOMEOWNERS OR ANYONE ELSE.

Therefore, Pacific, by providing information in good faith concerning the anticipated benefits of insulation and weatherization, or by entering into this agreement, does not warrant that the installation of the insulation and weatherization materials provided for in this agreement will result in savings of money or electrical consumption.

4. HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO REPAY

Individual Homeowners (natural persons) shall pay to Pacific, without interest, the actual contract cost of the insulation and weatherization prior to the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Homeowners other than natural persons prior to the sale of Gamaier for communication of any legal of expiration independent in any part of the insulation and weatherization within seven years of the date of this agreement. Homeowners may pay such cost to Pacific at any time prior to the time payment is due.

5. HOMEOWNERS' OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY

Homeowners shall notify Pacific in writing of the sale or transfer for consideration of any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property. Such notice shall be sent as soon as Homeowners know that there will be a sale or transfer for consideration, and not later than one week before the expected sale or transfer. 6. SECURITY INTEREST

To secure the Homeowners' obligations herein, Homeowners hereby mortgage to Pacific the property, together with all present and future appurtenances, improvements, and fixtures thereto. This paragraph shall not take effect until that date which is one day prior to the earliest to occur

(1) the date on which any legal or equitable interest in any part of the property is transferred;

7. PERFECTION OF SECURITY INTEREST

Pacific may record this agreement in the county real property records, and Homeowners shall execute any other documents deemed necessary by Pacific to perfect this security interest.

- 8. Each Homeowner who signs this agreement shall be individually and jointly responsible for performing the obligations of Homeowners in this agreement. This agreement shall be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties. Homeowners shall not assign this agreement without the
- 9. This document contains the entire agreement between the parties and shall not be modified except by a written instrument signed by the parties

10. HOMEOWNERS' RIGHT TO CANCEL (OREGON STATUTE)

If this agreement was solicited at a place other than the offices of Pacific, and you do not want the goods or services, you may cancel this agreement without any penalty, cancellation fee or other financial obligation by mailing a notice to Pacific. The notice must say that you do not want agreement without any penanty, cancenation tee of other inflancial congation by maning a notice to active. HOMEOWNER'S RIGHT TO CANCEL. (FEDERAL STATUTE). You, the Homeowner, may cancel this transaction at any time prior to midnight of the third business day after the date of this transaction.
