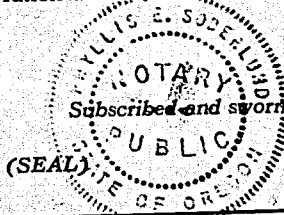

Both the beneficiary and the trustee have elected to sell the said real property to satisfy the obligations secured by said trust deed and a notice of default has been recorded pursuant to Section 86.735(3) of Oregon Revised Statutes; the default for which the foreclosure is made is grantor's failure to pay when due the following sums: Monthly installments of \$381.11 each, commencing with the payment due June 1, 1982 and continuing each month until this trust deed is reinstated or goes to Trustee's Sale; plus accrued late charges of \$106.68 as of December 17, 1982 and further late charges of \$15.24 on each delinquent payment after the 17th day of January, 1983; plus all other fees, costs and expenses associated with this foreclosure and plus the reserve account deficit balance of \$178.00.

By reason of said default the beneficiary has declared all obligations secured by said trust deed immediately due and payable, said sums being the following, to-wit: The sum of \$35,409.63 with interest thereon at the rate of 10.50% per annum from May 1, 1982, until paid; plus all other fees, costs and expenses associated with this foreclosure and plus the loan trust fund reserve deficit balance of \$178.00.

WHEREFORE, notice hereby is given that the undersigned trustee will on July 1, 1983, at the hour of 1:10 o'clock, P.M., Standard Time, as established by Section 187.110, Oregon Revised Statutes, at front door Klamath County Courthouse in the City of Klamath Falls, County of Klamath, State of Oregon, sell at public auction to the highest bidder for cash the interest in the said described real property which the grantor had or had power to convey at the time of the execution by him of the said trust deed, together with any interest which the grantor or his successors in interest acquired after the execution of said trust deed, to satisfy the foregoing obligations thereby secured and the costs and expenses of sale, including a reasonable charge by the trustee. Notice is further given that any person named in Section 86.760 of Oregon Revised Statutes has the right to have the foreclosure proceeding dismissed and the trust deed reinstated by payment to the beneficiary of the entire amount then due (other than such portion of said principal as would not then be due had no default occurred) together with costs and trustee's and attorney's fees as provided by law, at any time prior to five days before the date set for said sale.
