

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Donald G. Page and Yvonne Page, husband and wife

hereinafter called the grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated to the grantor paid by Lance O. McCord and Karen Sue McCord, husband and wife, hereinafter called the grantees, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the grantees, as tenants by the entirety, the heirs of the survivor and their assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 12, VILLA SAINT CLAIR, according to the official plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of Klamath County, Oregon.

1. The premises herein described are within and subject to the statutory powers, including the power of assessment, of Klamath Irrigation District.
2. The premises herein described are within and subject to the statutory powers, including the power of assessment, of South Suburban Sanitary District.
3. Reservations contained in Deed recorded June 13, 1944 in Volume 166, page 105, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon, to-wit: "Subject to certain governmental charges, and Klamath Irrigation District charges, and the roadways, ditches, and utility privileges (water, electricity, telephone, etc.) which may be necessary to cross the above lots, in order to make connections with other tracts in that platted area."

To Have and to Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said grantees, as tenants by the entirety, their heirs and assigns forever.

And grantor hereby covenants to and with grantees and the heirs of the survivor and their assigns, that grantor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, free from all encumbrances except as noted of record as of the date of this deed and those apparent upon the land, if any, as of the date of this deed,

grantor will warrant and forever defend the said premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except those claiming under the above described encumbrances. The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer, stated in terms of dollars, is \$16,000.00.
