Klamath County Planning Findings of Fact and Order

A hearing was held on this matter on July 21, 1983, pursuant to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 45.1, Klamath County, before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, Jim Spindor. The applicant was present. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Jonathan Chudnoff. The Hearings Reporter was Sharon Cosand.

12 Evidence was presented on behalf of the Department and on behalf of the applicant. There were no adjacent property owners

Klamath County Exhibit 2, Hearings Officer Order Dated 7-26-8 The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following Conclusions of Law:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- The proposed use is conditionally permitted within the 1. zone within which it is proposed to be located.
- The location, size, design and operating characteristics of the proposed use are in conformance with the Klamath County Comprehensive Plan.
 - The location, size, design and operating characteristics

of the proposed use will be compatible with and will not adversely affect the liveability of abutting property owners in the surrounding neighborhood.

- The location, design and site planning of the proposed use will provide a convenient and functional living environment and will be as attractive as the nature of the use and its location and setting warrant. 5.
- The granting of this conditional use permit is consistent with the goals of the LCDC. 6.
- This conditional use permit is granted subject to the following conditions: CONDITIONS:
- This Conditional Use Permit is granted for a period of one year, subject to renewal after a review of the applicant's operation at a public hearing.
- b. Applicant shall obtain approval from the Department of Environmental Quality and continue to have said approval for a site.
- 19 Applicant shall comply with all conditions written or oral imposed by him by the Department of Environmental Quality and the Klamath County Health Department. Any violation of the 21 conditions imposed by the Department of Environmental Quality or 22 the Klamath County Health Department, by the applicant or any persons using the facility, shall be considered to be a violation of the conditions of this Conditional Use Permit and shall subject the applicant to revocation of the Conditional Use Permit.
 - The applicant shall maintain approval of the facility by the Klamath County Health Department. CUP 81-17 (renewal)

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- This site shall be inspected and approved at least once a month by the Department of Environmental Quality and by the Klamath County Health Department. It is requested that they immediately advise the Klamath County Planning Department of any violations or alleged violations which they have found to occur on
- f. There shall be no more than three (3) disposal permits upon this site, only two (2) of which may be actively dumped into at any one time.
- 10 The area of the site shall be fenced sufficiently to keep persons, livestock and deer off the site. The fence which is 12 built shall at least meet the specifications of the Oregon State 13 Department of Fish and Wildlife with regard to deer. 14 applicant shall build an additional gate and any appropriate 15 related fencing at least 200 feet away from the disposal pits and construct it along the access road so that vehicles could not 17 avoid the gate and dump into the pits by use of hose or other This gate shall be locked at all times. 19 shall additionally place a gate and fencing around each of the 20 pits and each of these gates shall additionally be locked at all The applicant 21 kimes. 22
 - The applicant shall maintain permission to use an adequate access road to the site and shall have written proof thereof available to the Planning Department upon request.
- 25 The applicant shall follow the direction of the Klamath 26 County Public Works Department with regard to the access road 27 From the private property to Lower Lake Road. The applicant shall 28 btain liability insurance sufficient to cover all prospective

claims in the amount of at least \$1,000,000.00.

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- The applicant shall require all users of the solid waste disposal pits to sign agreements with him wherein they contract to indemnify him for all penalties and all other damages and losses which he or neighboring or surrounding property owners may incur from the user's use of the facility. Copies of these contracts shall be filed with the Klamath County Planning Department within five (5) days of their signing. not allow anyone to use the facility without their signing of The applicant shall these contracts. The applicant may provide other conditions and terms in these agreements as he sees fit.
- 12 The applicant shall immediately report to the Klamath County Planning Department and the Department of Environmental Quality and the Klamath County Health Department when he has any reason to believe whatsoever that material has been dumped into any of the pits which is not authorized under his Department of Environmental Quality operating permit.
- 18 1. Prior to the dumping of any material into any of the pits other than septic tank effluent, the applicant shall obtain written permission from the Klamath County Hearings Officer or 20 the Assistant Hearings Officer after appropriate notice and Hearing. 21 22 This written permission shall be in addition to any permission which the applicant must obtain from the Health Department, Department of Environmental Quality or other Federal agencies.
 - If the applicant constructs a third pit, it shall be located as close as physically possible midway between the two existing pits on the facility.
- The applicant shall devise a form which he shall require CUP 81-17 (renewal) Page 4

all users of the facility to fill in and deposit in some type of depository box on the site each time the user makes any type of dump into the facility. This form shall include, but is not 5 1. A statement as to where the effluent came from including all the various pieces of property from which the user obtained material to be dumped; 2. A statement as to when the material to be dumped was picked up; 10 The total amount of material to be dumped; and 11 The time in which he has dumped the material into 12 the ponds/pits. 13 The applicant shall then file these forms with the Klamath 14 County Planning Department on a monthly basis. The applicant as 15 a user of the facility is also required to fill out these forms 16 and file them as set forth above. 17 o. The applicant shall, to the extent reasonably possible, 18 use the facility during the daylight hours. This condition is 19 not intended to prevent the applicant or other users from using the facility during the hours after sunset or before sunrise. However, it is intended only to recommend to the applicant and his authorized users that they use the facility as much as possible 23 during the daylight hours.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

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The requested use has been granted with conditions based on 26 the following findings of fact: 1.

The findings of fact as set forth in Klamath County 28 Exhibit "B" are adopted for the purpose of the approval with

conditions herein.

2. There was testimony that all of the conditions set forth in Klamath County Exhibit "B" are still necessary, and that there are no new conditions needed at this time.

3. There was testimony that there have been no complaints with regard to the operation of the applicant during the last year. No one testified in opposition to the renewal of this conditional use permit, and there was no evidence presented that there would be any detrimental affect to the surrounding neighborhood.

The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

That real property described as:

"being generally located in the Klamath Hills east of Lower Lake Road approximately 1½ miles south of its junction with Cross Road, and more particularly described as a parcel of land located in the NE½ of Section 17, Township 40, Range 9, Klamath County, Oregon,"

is hereby granted a Conditional Use Permit renewal in accordance with the terms of the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 45.1, and, henceforth, will be allowed renewal of operation of solid waste disposal site.
