Where such consent is given, borrower must promptly notify nortgages in writing of a transfer of ownership of the premises or any interest in same, and furnish a copy of the instrument of transfer. Transferee shall pay interest as prescribed by ORS 407.070 on all payments due from the date of transfer.
- 12. The balance of this loan is immediately due and payable in full upon the second sale or other transfer of all or part of the property securing this loan after July 1, 1983. However, transfer or sale to the original borrower, the surviving spouse, unremarried former spouse, surviving child or stepchild of the original borrower, or to a veteran eligible for a loan under ORS 407.010 to 407.210 and Article XI-A of the Oregon Constitution does not count as a sale or transfer for purposes of the provisions of this paragraph.
