This Conditional Use Permit No. 15-83 for the Inter-6 national Woodworkers Association came on for hearing before the 7 Klamath County Planning Commission with public hearings having 8 been heard on July 26, 1983, wherefrom the testimony, reports, 9 and information produced at the hearing by the applicant, Planning 10 Staff and other persons in attendance, the Planning Commission denied the Conditional Use Permit request for a tavern in the 11 | 12 General Commercial zone to allow the sale of alcoholic beverages.

The applicant, International Woodworkers Association, 14 appealed the Conditional Use Permit to the Board of Commissioners on September 26, 1983, and wherefrom the testimony, reports, and 16 information on the record produced at the hearing by the applicant Planning Staff, and other persons who had given previous testimony the Board of County Commissioners approved the Conditional Use Permit for use of a tavern for sale of alcoholic beverages.

The Board of County Commissioners makes the following Findings of Fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- The Board of County Commissioners finds the applicant who made the request to be the International Woodworkers Association with the representative being Mary and Dave Woodard and Rita McDonald.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners finds that the property for change by the Conditional Use Permit was located in

Township 36, Section 34, Range 14, being Tax Lot 300. 1 2 The Board of County Commissioners finds from applicant and others in attendance that the site for use of a tavern was in 3 an area where there were commercial uses as well as individual uses and appeared to be in a business area of the town of Bly. 5 6 4. The Board of County Commissioners finds that the parcel for change was rectangular in shape and approximately 7 2½ acres in size. 9 5. The Board of County Commissioners finds that the site for Conditional Use Permit for use of a tavern did meet 10 Paragraph A, B, C, & D, of Section 44.003, of the Land Development 11 Code, which is the criteria to approve a Conditional Use Permit. 13 6. The Board of County Commissioners finds that the plot plan as submitted by the applicant indicated that site had 14 adequate parking, and that all setbacks were met per zoning 15 16 regulations. 17 The Board of County Commissioners finds that it was pointed out that the proposed use would not adversely effect 18 19 the surrounding neighborhood. 20 The Board of County Commissioners finds that the 8. 21 testimony also indicated that the proposed use did fit in with 22 the area and that there was a need for a tavern as the other 23 taverns in the town of Bly had burned down. 24 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW: 25 1. The proposed use is conditionally permitted in the 26 zone whithin which it is proposed to be located. 27 2. The location, size, design and operating characteristics of the proposed use are in conformance with the Klamath 28
