

QUITCLAIM DEED

PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a Maine corporation, hereby releases and quitclaims to Klamath County, State of Oregon, a political subdivision, all its right, title and interest arising out of that certain conveyance designated as "Grant of Right-of-Way" granted by John F. Dixon and Lucile Dixon, husband and wife, on April 29, 1926, and recorded in Volume 69, Page 545, Records of Klamath County, Oregon, described as:

All that portion of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eighteen (18) in Township Thirty Nine (39) South of Range Ten (10) East of the W.M. lying South and West of the Main Government Irrigation Canal in Klamath County, State of Oregon, excepting the following portion of same deeded to John Koontz, said deed recorded in Vol. 62 of Deeds, Page 609, Records of Klamath County, Oregon, to wit: Beginning at the point formed by the intersection of the westerly boundary line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 18 Township and Range aforesaid with the southerly or westerly boundary line of the right-of-way of the Government Canal known as the "A" Canal thence South on said westerly boundary line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 18 a distance of 605 feet; thence due East a distance of 644 feet to the southerly or westerly boundary line of said right-of-way of said Government Canal; thence in a northwesterly direction along said southerly or westerly boundary line of said right-of-way to the point of beginning containing 4.7 acres.

The said right-of-way shall be located not to exceed eleven (11) feet East of the East Boundary and parallel to The Dalles-California State Highway as is now officially located, and shall be limited to two poles.


