

The Cooperative may limit the amount of electric energy furnished for industrial purposes. The Applicant will pay a bill of at least \$45.00 per month.

The Applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by the Cooperative and in conformity with the law, National Electric Code, National Safety Code and any applicable 50 The Applicant, by paying a deposit fee, assumes no personal liability or responsibility for any debts or liabilities of the Cooperative. 5. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by such rules and regulations as may be established by the Board of Directors from time to time.
