Melvin L. Chiloquin, Pipeholder, has vested powers to perform marriage; conduct funerals; take, as pastor, our Indian church to perform all vital duties, social, spiritual, and emotional, peculiar to this office.

Motion was passed unanimously. This is to be registered at the county clerk's office, county of Klamath, state of Oregon at once.
