The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following 21 22 Conclusions of Law:

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. The proposed use is conditionally permitted in the zone 25 within which it is proposed to be located. 26

The location, size, design and operating characteristics 2. 27 of the proposed use are in conformance with the Klamath County 28 Comprehensive Plan.

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The location, size, design and operating characteristics 3. of the proposed use will be compatible with and will not adversely 2 affect the liveability of abutting property owners in the surround 3 ing neighborhood. 4

5 The location, design and site planning of the proposed 4. $\mathbf{6} \|$ use will provide a convenient and functional living environment and will be as attractive as the nature of the use and its loca-8 tion and setting warrant.

5. The granting of this Conditional Use Permit is consistent 10 with the goals of the LCDC.

6. The granting of this Conditional Use Permit is subject 12 to the following conditions:

13 CONDITIONS:

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a. Use of the mobile home shall be limited to family members 15 of the owner; and

The applicant shall maintain a clear driveway access b. of at least eleven feet in width from Cottage Avenue, by the house 17 18 in existence, to the mobile home; or, he shall develop an alter-19 native route for firefighting equipment to reach said mobile home 20 and shall submit written proof of said alternative route to the 21 Klamath County Planning Department.

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FINDINGS OF FACT:

The Conditional Use Permit requested has been granted based 24 on the following findings of fact: 25

1. The applicant makes this request to allow placement of a 26 mobile home on his lot which is located in the Suburban Residential zone. The property in question is .49 acres, being 80 feet by 27 28 265.7 feet. The property is rectangular in shape. The request C.U.P. 34-83 Page 2

_ 572 is to permit a mobile home to be placed on the property for 1 applicant's son in addition to the house on the property. The 2 general area consists of mostly one-half acre to cheracre lots, 3 developed for single family residential use. A number of properties 4 in this area have mobile homes in addition to the house. The apple-5 cant stated that he does not intend to use the mobile home for 6 7 other than his family members. 8 2. No one testified in opposition to the granting of the Conditional Use Permit, and there was no evidence presented that 9 10 there would be any detrimental effect to the public health, safety or welfare, or any detrimental effect on abutting property owners. 11 12 The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of 13 Fact, accordingly orders as follows: 14 That real property described as 15 "being generally located at 5523 Cottage Avenue, and more particularly described as Lot 75, Pleasant Home 16 Tracts #2, Klamath County, Oregon," 17 is hereby granted a Conditional Use Permit in accordance with the terms of the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance No. 45.1, and, 18 19 henceforth, will be allowed a mobile home for a family member in 20 the RS (Suburban Residential) zone.
