

STATEMENT OF ACCOUNT OFFORECLOSURE SALEPOSSESSORY CHATTEL LIEN



No. 2034, to satisfy a possessory chattel lien on behalf of the lienholders, Elmer Jacobs and Jeanette Jacobs, husband and wife.


The sale occurred at 3:00 p.m. The amount of the lien claim was \$3,130.16. The cost of foreclosing the lien was \$82.94, for a total lien claim of \$3,213.08. A copy of the published Notice of Foreclosure Sale and Affidavit from the Herald and News, a newspaper published in Klamath County, Oregon, is attached hereto.

The amount received for the chattel sold at the sale was the sum of \$3,213.08. Therefore, there were no excess proceeds to be paid to the Treasurer of Klamath County pursuant to ORS 87.206.
