3. To comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions allecting said property; it the beneficiary so requests, to join in executing such linancing statements pursuant to the Uniform Commercial Code as the beneficiary may require and to pay for lifting same in the proper public office or offices, as well as the cost of all lien searches made by filing officers or searching agencies as may be deemed desirable by the beneficiary.

3. To comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, continions and restrictions allecting said property; if the beneficiary so requires and to pay for liting same in the proper public office or offices, as well as the cost of all lien searches made by liting folicers or searching agencies as may be deemed desirable by the beneficiary.

11. The entering upon and taking possession of said property, the collection of such rents, issues and profits, or the proceeds of lire and other insurance policies or compensation or release thereof as aloresaid, shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereunder or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.

12. Upon default by grantor in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in his performance of any agreement hereunder, the beneficiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable. In such an event the beneficiary at his election may proceed to loreclose this trust deed by advertisement and sale. In the latter event the beneficiary or the trustee shall execute and cause to be recorded his written notice of default and his election to sell the said described real property to satisfy the obligations secured hereby, whereupon the trustee shall lix the time and place of sale, five notice thereof as then required by law and proceed to loreclose this trust deed in the manner provided in ORS 86.740 to 86.739.

11. Should the beneficiary elect to loreclose by advertisement and sale then after default at any time prior to live days before the date set by the trustee or the trustee's sale, the grantor or other person so privileged by ORS 86.760, may pay to the beneficiary or his successors in interest, respectively, the entire amount then due under the terms of the trust deed and the obligation secured thereby (including costs and expenses actually incurred in enforcing the terms of the obligation and trustee's and attorney's lees not exceeding the amounts provided by law) other than such portion of the principal as would not then be due had no default occurred, and thereby cure the default, in which event all loreclosure proceedings shall be dismissed by the trustee.

14. Otherwise, the sale shall be held on the date and at the time and place designated in the notice of sale or the time to which said sale may be postponed as provided by law. Trustee is not obligated to notify any party hereto of pending sale under any other deed of trust or of any action or proceeding in which grantor, beneficiary or trustee shall be a party unless such action or proceeding is brought by trustee.
