ORDER

This Comprehensive Land Use Plan Map Change and Zone Change No. 23-83 for Michael Jager, came on for hearing before the Klamath County Planning Commission with public hearing having been heard on December 20, 1983, wherefrom the testimony, reports and information produced at the hearing by the applicant, planning staff and other persons in attendance, on January 24, 1984, the Planning Commission denied the CLUP and Zone Change request from EFU (Exclusive Farm Use) to R (Rural) to allow a 5-acre minimum lot size in the area.

The Planning Commission makes the following Findings of Fact:

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The Planning Commission finds the applicant to be Michael Jager. 2.
- The property for change in Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone was located in the W 1/2, NE 1/4 and SE 1/4, NE 1/4 of Section 31, Township 37, Range 11, being a portion of Tax Lot
- The parcel for change was rectangular in shape and approximately 15 acres in size.
- Testimony indicated with a five-acre minimum being applied to the proposed site, the possibility of three more parcels could be partitioned out.
  - 5. It was pointed out to the Planning Commission from

testimony that in the surrounding area it was basically an area where agricultural units were 40 acres and larger in size.

- It was pointed out to the Planning Commission that the site was near a low density deer winter range and by further development and subsequent partitioning, the proposed use could affect the deer winter range.
- 7. By allowing this change to be approved, the Planning Commission felt that the proposed use would not be compatible with the surrounding area.
- 8. The Planning Commission felt that the exceptions paper did not include enough solid factors to take an exception to this property.

The following Conclusions of Law are based on the foregoing 14 | Findings of Fact:

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- The Planning Commission concludes that this change in Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Zone would not permit orderly and beneficial development, and would not protect the character of the neighborhood.
- The Planning Commission concludes that this request for change would not further the goals and policies of the Klamath County Comprehensive Plan as adopted by the Board of Commissioners on December 21, 1982.
