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1 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW: 2 The proposed use is conditionally permitted within the 15088 1. zone within which it is proposed to be located. 3 4 The location, size, design and operating characteristics of the proposed use are in conformance with the Klamath 5 County Comprehensive Plan. 6 7 The location, size, design and operating characteristics of the proposed development will be compatible with and will not 8 have significant adverse effects on the appropriate development 9 and use of abutting property owners and the surrounding area. 10 11 4. The granting of this conditional use permit is consistent with the goals of the L.C.D.C. 12 13 The granting of this conditional use permit is subject 14 to the following conditions: 15 (1) The applicant shall follow their plot plan 16 which is Exhibit "C" herein. 17 (2) The applicant shall provide adequate 18 parking space. 19 (3) The applicant shall not install any signs 20 without first obtaining the necessary permit 21 from the Oregon Highway Division. 22 FINDINGS OF FACT: 23 The conditional use permit has been granted with conditions 24 based on the following findings of fact: 25 This application is by the Saving Grace Lutheran Church of Keno, which proposes to buy and use the former Western Bank 26 site on Highway 66. The congregation has a membership of about 27 28 22 families, with a typical Sunday attendance being 25 persons. C.U.P. 33-84 Page 2

15089 2. The church activities include Sunday services and 1 religious school and occasional meetings at other times. At 2 present the congregation is using the facilities of another 3 church in Keno. 4 3. The property in question is in the Highway-Commercial 5 zone. This property is rectangular in shape, covering approxi-6 mately 24,500 square feet. The property is within a developed 7 rural community in an area committed to residential, commercial 8 and civic uses. No one testified in opposition to the granting 9 of this conditional use permit and there was no evidence 10 presented that there would be any adverse effects on the 11 appropriate development and use of the abutting property and 12 the surrounding area. 13 The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of 14 Fact, accordingly orders as follows: 15 That real property described as 16 "Being generally located on the north side of 17 State Highway 66 and in the community of Keno, and more particularly described as being 18 located in the NW4 of Section 6, Township 40, Range 8, Tax Lot 402, and Section 1, Town-snip 40, Range 7, Tax Lot 100," 19 20 is hereby conditionally granted a Conditional Use Permit in 21 accordance with the terms of the Klamath County Zoning Ordinance 22 No. 45.2, and, henceforth, will be allowed to establish a 23 religious assembly in the CH (Highway Commercial) zone. 24 Entered at Klamath Falls, Oregon, this 28-25 day of August, 1984. 26 KLAMATH COUNTY HEARINGS DIVISION 27 28 Ret: Commissioners Journal Hearings Officer C.U.P. 33-84 Page 3
