- 1. The Petitioner was a resident of the State of Oregon for more than six months prior to the filing of the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage;
- 2. There were no other lawsuits pending in any other Court regarding this matter;
- 3. The parties were lawfully married in the State of California on November 5, 1955; and
- 4. Irreconcileable differences between the parties have caused the irremediable breakdown of the marriage; and

Being satisfied in all particulars, NOW THEREFORE enters its Decree as follows:

1. That the marriage between the parties is hereby dissolved effective the |Y| day of |Y| (c.c.)

- 6. Respondent shall pay unto the Department of Human Resources IP.O. Box 2506, Salem, Oregon 97308, as spousal support the sum of \$150.00 per month until Petitioner reaches the age of 65 years, further Order of the Court, depending upon a change of circumstances.

It is acknowledged the Respondent has made a support payment for March 1978. Therefore, the date of his first payment under the terms of this Decree shall be April 1, 1978.
