DECREE OF DISSOLUTION
OF MARRIAGE

10 THIS MATTER having come on before the Court; the
11 Petitioner appearing by and through her attorney, Beth Aronoff;
12 the Respondent appearing by and through his attorney, James J.
13 Spindor; the Petitioner having filed an Affidavit in lieu of
14 the hearing pursuant to ORS 107.095(4); and the parties being in
15 agreement with the entry of this Decree of Dissolution; and the
16 Court being fully advised in the premises, finds that irreconcil-
17 able differences between the parties have caused the irremediable
18 breakdown of the marriage, now, therefore,

19 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the
20 marriage contract of the parties heretofore existing between
21 Petitioner and Respondent is hereby terminated and dissolved;
22 that this Decree of Dissolution between Petitioner and Respondent
23 shall become finally effective to dissolve the marriage status of
24 the parties upon the expiration of thirty days from the date
25 hereof, to-wit: *December 11*, 1984, or if an appeal is taken,
26 on the date on which this suit is determined on such appeal,

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1 whichever is later; in case either party dies within the thirty
2 day period specified above, this Decree of Dissolution of
3 Marriage shall be considered to have entirely terminated the
4 marriage relationship of the parties immediately before such
5 death unless an appeal is pending as aforesaid; and

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that as of
7 the date hereof:

8 1. Petitioner is awarded the care, custody and control
9 of the minor children of the parties, namely: Michael Scott Glawe,
10 a boy, born 2/18/67, and Angela Christine Glawe, a girl, born
11 11/26/76. Respondent is awarded reasonable rights of visitation
12 with regard to his daughter Angela Christine Glawe such as will not
13 interfere with her health, education and welfare, including but not
14 limited as follows: One weekend per month from Friday at 7:00 P.M.
15 until Sunday at 5:00 P.M. beginning with the month of December,
16 1984; a telephone conversation with said child each Wednesday at
17 8:00 P.M. commencing with Wednesday, November 28, 1984; said tele-
18 phone conversation shall be initiated by the child who shall call
19 collect. Further, every other Thanksgiving from Wednesday at 7:00
20 P.M. through Saturday at 7:00 P.M. commencing with the Thanksgiving
21 of 1985, one-half of each Christmas school vacation commencing
22 with the Christmas of 1984 as well as two consecutive weeks each
23 summer starting with the summer of 1985. With regard to the visi-
24 tation with said child, Respondent shall give the Petitioner not
25 less than 48 hours notice prior to exercising any of the above-
26 mentioned visitation with the exception of the Wednesday night

1 telephone calls. Further Respondent shall not have overnight
2 visitation with said child until she is twelve years of age unless
3 another adult is present.

4 With regard to the child Michael Scott Glawe, the
5 Respondent shall have reasonable rights of visitation such as
6 will not interfere with his health, education and welfare.

7 2. Petitioner is awarded a judgment against Respondent
8 in the sum of \$150.00 per month per child for a total of \$300.00
9 per month as and for child support through the month of May, 1985;
10 commencing with the month of June, 1985, Respondent's duty of
11 child support with regard to the child Michael Scott Glawe shall
12 terminate, and his duty of child support with regard to the child
13 Angela Christine Glawe shall increase to the sum of \$250.00 per
14 month and shall continue thereafter during her minority and there-
15 after until the age of 21 years should she be attending school
16 pursuant to ORS 107.108. Said child support payment shall be
17 made through the Clerk of the Klamath County Court commencing
18 December 10, 1984.

19 3. Each of the parties hereto shall maintain the medical
20 insurance policies available through their places of employment for
21 the benefit of their minor children, during the minority of said
22 children. Should both parties have such insurance policies, the
23 Petitioner shall be the primary policy holder. Further, any
24 reasonable medical, dental or related costs which are not covered
25 by said insurance policies shall be divided equally between
26 Petitioner and Respondent.

1 4. Petitioner is awarded the residence and real
2 property of the parties located on Brennan Drive, Keno, Oregon,
3 more particularly described as:

4 Portion of West 1/2 Southeast 1/4, Section
5 36, Township 39 South, Range 7 E.W.M.,
6 Klamath County, Oregon,

7 free and clear of any interest of the Respondent therein except
8 as set forth hereinbelow. Petitioner shall be responsible for
9 any and all encumbrances on said property and shall hold the
10 Respondent harmless therefrom.

11 Respondent's interest in said real property is adjudged
12 to be the sum of \$9,850.00 at this time; Petitioner shall sell
13 said residence and real property by the time the child Angela
14 Christine Glawe reaches 19 years of age and upon said sale shall
15 pay the Respondent the sum of \$9,850.00 or one-half of her net
16 gain from the sale of said property, whichever is less. In the
17 event Petitioner wishes to retain the residence upon the child
18 Angela Christine Glawe's reaching 19 years of age, Petitioner
19 shall pay the Respondent the sum of \$9,850.00, all due and payable
20 on November 26, 1995. Net gain shall be determined by reducing
21 the gross sales price by the amount of any encumbrance still
22 existing which exists as of this date, as well as by any reasonable
23 costs of sale. Respondent shall not receive any interest with
24 regard to his above-mentioned interest in said residence and real
25 property.

26 5. Petitioner shall not receive any spousal support
with regard to this marriage.

1 6. Petitioner is awarded the 1968 Mustang, the 1980
2 Pontiac and the 1965 Ford pickup of the parties free and clear
3 of any interest of the Respondent therein; Petitioner shall be
4 responsible for any and all encumbrances against said vehicles
5 and shall hold the Respondent harmless therefrom.

6 7. Respondent is awarded the 1982 Datsun pickup and
7 the 1975 Ford pickup of the parties free and clear of any interest
8 of the Petitioner therein; Respondent shall be responsible for any
9 and all encumbrances thereon and shall hold Petitioner harmless
10 therefrom.

11 8. Each of the parties shall be awarded the personal
12 property not mentioned hereinabove which they individually possess
13 as of the date of this Decree.

14 9. Each of the parties shall be responsible for the
15 following family debts and hold the other party harmless therefrom:

3 13. Attorney James J. Spindor is hereby discharged
4 as attorney.
