The hearing was then closed, and based upon the evidence
 submitted at the hearing, the Hearings Officer made the following
 Conclusions of Law:

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

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2 1. The proposed use is conditionally permitted in the zone within which it is proposed to be located.

2. The location, size, design, and operating characteris-5 tics of the proposed use are in conformance with the Klamath County Comprehensive Plan.

3. The location, size, design, and operating characteris-8 tics of the proposed use will be compatible with and will not have a significant acverse effect on the appropriate development Q 10 and use of abutting property and the surrounding neighborhood. 11 4. The granting of this conditional use permit is con-12 sistent with the goals of the L.C.D.C. 13

.5. The conditional use permit is granted subject to the 14 following conditions:

(a) Access to the property shall be limited to one driveway, which driveway shall be from Hichway 422 and which shall be located as far as possible from the Highway 62 intersection. The final location and design of this driveway shall be approved by the Oregon State Highway Division, and the applicant shall provide proof to the Klamath County Planning Department that he has obtained the approval of the Oregon State Highway Division ... (b)

The applicant shall obtain approval for a septic system from the Klamath County Health Department. (c) The property shall be fenced with a fence adequate to keep cattle out prior to the building being used.

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

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2 The requested use has been granted with conditions based 3 on the following findings of fact:

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1. The request herein is by the Chiloquin congregation 4 of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints to allow 5 a church in the EFU-CG zone. The property involved is a 2.52 6 acre parcel which will be partitioned from a 26.2 acre tract 7 upon approval of this permit. The property in question is 8 located at the intersection of Highway 62 and 422 South, and 9 provides a convenient access for a congregation whose membership 10 is drawn from the Chîloquin, Fort Klamath, and Agency Lake areas. 11 The Chiloquin-Agency Lake area is Klamath County's most rapidly 12 developing rural residential area. The property in question is 13 diamond in shape. 14

The congregation of the church numbers 29 families
 with a total of 111 members. Growth is expected to the at a 3%
 annual rate. Regular church attendance is now about 70, with
 the proposed building to have an initial capacity of a little
 over 100. The regular church schedule includes Sunday services
 and school and two weeknight activities. Some weekday classes
 or activities may take place.

3. The area to the east and south is mostly in rural
homesites of 2½ to 10 acres. To the north are large: (20+ acres)
tracts of unusual brushland. There is irrigated pasture to the
west.

26 4. The property is on a pumice and rock upland, mostly
27 brush covered. No irrigation is available, and there is no farm
28 use on the land. The only nearby farm operation consists of

C.U.P. 1-85 Page 3 irrigated pasture across Highway 62 to the west. No farm and would be taken out of production by this proposal.

5. The property is in an area of brushy, sparsely wooded ridges. There is no timber management in the area, nor are any other forest uses defined by Goal 4 established in the area. 5

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6. There are no Goal 5 resources on or adjacent to this 6 property. 7

7. A septic system on the property would be subject to 8 review and approval by the Klamath County Health Department. 9

8. The area has a high fire hazard rating. The property 10 is within the Chiloquin-Agency Lake fire district, with fire 11 stations at Chiloquin and Agency Loop Road, approximately 33 12 miles away. 13

9. The property fronts on two paved state highways. 14 Traffic on Highway 422 is required to stop at the intersection, 15 while Highway 62 traffic is at high speed. 16

10. The only objection came from a nearby property owner 17 as set forth in Exhibit "E" herein. There is no evidence that 18 the granting of this conditional use permit would have any 19 adverse effect on the abutting property owner or the surrounding 20

neighborhood. 21

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The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of 22

Fact, accordingly orders as follows: 23

The real property described as:

"Being generally located at the junction of Highways 62 and 422 South, and more particularly described as being located in a portion of Government Lots 24 and 25, Section 8, Township 35, Range 7,"

is hereby conditionally granted a conditional use permit in
