12. 16. For any reason permitted by law beneficiary may from time to time appoint a successor to successors to any trustee named herein or to any successor trustee, appointed hereunder. Upon such appointment, and without conveyance to the successor trustee, the latter shall be vested with all tills, powers and duties conferred upon any trustee herein named or appointed hereunder. Each such appointment and substitution shall be made by written instrument executed by beneficiary, containing reterence to this trust deed and its place of record, which, when recorded in the office of the County Olerk or Recorder of the county or counties in which the property is situated, shall be conclusive proof of proper appointment of the successor trustee.
