

WHEREAS, the United States of America, acting by and through the Forest Service, USDA, owns and controls a portion of a road known as "Route S-27, MERRITT SPRINGS ROAD," in the SE1/4NE1/4, section 5, T. 33 S., R. 7 E., W.M., Klamath County, Oregon, by virtue of a conveyance from Klamath County as Grantor, which stated: "... Grantor does hereby donate, remise, release, and quitclaim unto the Government under ORS 271.330 (1), any right, title, or interest it may have or possess in or to the following described roads, . . .," and


WHEREAS, Klamath County acquired said right, title, and interest to said road by virtue of an instrument dated July 6, 1960, and recorded in Vol 344, page 51, Klamath County Records, and, from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, USDI, pursuant to the Act of August 13, 1954, (68 Stat. 718) as amended.

WHEREAS, the United States of America, acting by and through its Department of Interior-Bureau of Indian Affairs "Grantee," acquired an easement and right-of-way for said road by virtue of an easment dated March 25, 1960, and recorded in Vol. 320, page 148, Klamath County Records, from the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Board of Forestry, "Grantor," subject to the following conditions: "TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said easement and way unto the Grantee, forever; provided; however, Grantee shall have the right and privilege to assign all its right, title, and interest in and to said easement and way to Klamath County, Oregon, for public road purposes; otherwise, upon failure of Grantee to use said easement and way for the purposes herein designated, all right, title, and interest of Grantee shall revert to Grantor, or the successors and assigns of Grantor."

NOW THEREFORE, this instrument is executed for the purpose of showing that the United States of America has no further need or use for the easements or portions thereof for the above described road and said easements or portions thereof reverts to the State of Oregon Board of Forestry or its successors or assigns.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the United States of America, by its Director of Lands, Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, has executed this instrument this 19th day of April, 1985.

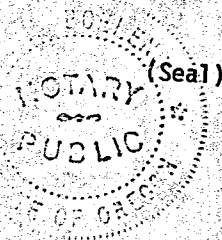
