NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a placer deposit of locatable minerals upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon, have located and hereby do place a placer claim of 1.60 acres by posting this notice of location on a post or monument in a conspicuous place inside the boundaries of the claim. The claim is named the High Providence #10 (ten) Claim, which is described as follows (fill out one of the two sections below):

(1) If claim is on surveyed land:

This claim comprises the Northwest Quarter of Section 3 (Three) Township 32 South, Range 7½ East, of the Willamette Meridian, in the State of Oregon. The location notice (also discovery monument) stands 2175 feet (approx.) on a 111° true bearing from the Northwest corner of Section 3 (as above).

(2) If claim is on unsurveyed public land or is on surveyed land, and it is not practicable to describe claim by legal subdivisions:

The distance between posts may not exceed 1,320 feet. The number of posts will vary depending on the size of the claim.

The locators intend to hold and work the above described claim as provided by the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon and claim all of the rights and privileges granted by existing laws and customs. In construing this location notice, the singular includes the plural and vice versa if the context so requires.
