Amended Notice of Location of Placer Claim Vol. 1785 Page 10632

STATE of OREGON, County of Klamath Mining District.

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a placer deposit of locatable minerals upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon, have located and hereby do locate a placer claim of 160 acres by posting this notice of location on a post or monument in a conspicuous place inside the boundaries of the claim. The claim is named the High Providence #40 (Conty.) Claim, which is described as follows (fill out one of the two sections below):

(1) If claim is on surveyed land:

This claim comprises the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 29 South, Range 7 East, of the Willamette Meridian, State of Oregon.

(2) If claim is on unsurveyed public land or if on surveyed land, and it is not practicable to describe claim by legal subdivisions: The distance between posts may not exceed 1,320 feet. The number of posts will vary depending on the size of the claim.

This claim is situated in the (quarter section) of Section Township, Range of the Meridian, either as surveyed by the U.S. Government or protracted if the land is unsurveyed.

The locators intend to hold and work the above described claim as provided by the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon and claim all of the rights and privileges granted by existing laws and customs. In construing this location notice, the singular includes the plural and vice versa if the context so requires.
