R E S O L U T I O N # 101

WHEREAS, on July 21, 1980 the Forest Service and Klamath County entered into an agreement whereby the Forest Service would construct the 4.5 mile section of the Squaw Flat Road from the Southerly Forest Service boundary to the Northern Forest Service boundary to a double lane County standard, up to and including a driveable gravel surface; and

WHEREAS, Klamath County agreed that upon completion of the construction, the County would accept and record a standard United States Department of Agriculture Easement which transfers responsibility for all maintenance, including traffic control and traffic control devices to Klamath County; and

WHEREAS, the Forest Service has completed the construction of the 4.5 mile segment of the Squaw Flat Road from the Southern Forest Service boundary to the Northern Forest Service boundary and granted Klamath County an Easement for that portion of the road; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Klamath County, Oregon sitting in regular session deemed it to be in the best interests of said County to accept the hereinabove segment of roadway for County Road purposes;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the roadway Easement conveyed to Klamath County by the United States of America, acting by and through the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture on the 19th day of June, 1985 shall be accepted as County Road right-of-way for the Squaw Flat Road.
