 hereinafter called the grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated, to grantor paid by Guy A. Galletti,
 and Karen L. Griffith, husband and wife,
 the grantee, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath and State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

The NW^{1/4} and SW^{1/4} SW^{1/4} lying North of the USBR Drain No. 1 and Southwesterly of the Southern Pacific Railroad of Section 26, Township 39 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian and that portion of SE^{1/4} SE^{1/4} lying North of the USBR Drain #1 in Section 27, Township 39 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian;

EXCEPTING THEREFROM the following: Beginning at the intersection of the Easterly right of way of the County Road known as the Spring Lake Road, (said road being along the West line of the SE^{1/4} SE^{1/4} of Section 27, T. 39 S., R. 9 E.W.M.) and Northerly line of the U.S.B.R. Drain No. 1; thence North along the Easterly right of way of the Spring Lake Road 370.0 feet; thence East at right angles to the said Spring Lake Road 672.55 feet to the Northerly right of way of the U.S.B.R. Drain No. 1; thence South 61°11' West along the Northerly right of way of said No. 1 Drain 767.62 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

 And said grantor hereby covenants to and with said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that grantor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, free from all encumbrances.

EXCEPTIONS:

1. Taxes for 1985-86 are now a lien but not yet payable.
2. The assessment roll and the tax roll disclose that the within described premises were specially assessed as farm land. Taxes for the year 1984-85, and possibly prior years have been deferred pursuant to ORS 308.370 to 308.403. These, plus earned interest are due and payable when said reason for the deferment no longer exist.
3. Acreage and use limitations under provisions of United States Statutes and regulations issued thereunder.
4. Liens and assessments of Klamath Project and Klamath Irrigation District, and regulations, contracts, easements, water and irrigation rights in connection therewith.
5. Any unpaid charges or assessments of the Klamath Irrigation District.
6. Easement for a road, including the terms and provisions thereof, executed by Alice E. West and W.J. West, her husband to Mary L. Moore, dated November 8, 1921, recorded December 2, 1921, in Volume 58 page 237, Deed records of Klamath County, Oregon.
7. Reservations and restrictions, including the terms and provisions thereof, in deed from Klamath Irrigation District, to E.G. and Dorothy Born, dated October 5, 1939, recorded October 7, 1939, in Volume 125 page 24, Deed records of Klamath County, Oregon, as follows: "It is expressly understood and agreed that neither the grantor nor the U.S. which operates and maintains the irrigation works of grantor, shall at any time be required to furnish through existing ditches, or to repair, construct or maintain any irrigation ditches or drainage ditches used or to be used in connection with said lands and further the grantor expressly reserves and shall keep and retain any payment or refund which may in future be made by the U.S. by reason of any reclassification of said lands."
8. Reservations and restrictions, including the terms and provisions thereof, contained in deed from Klamath Irrigation District, to Guy A. Galletti, dated March 9, 1959, recorded April 7, 1959 in Volume 311 page 300, Deed records of Klamath County, Oregon, as follows: "Grantee for himself and his heirs and assigns, as owners of the granted premises, will pay proportionate part of costs of maintaining private ditches appurtenant to the premises in the ratio of amount of irrigation water conducted therethrough and used on said premises to that used on other lands irrigated from said ditches, and further agrees that all of the granted premises shall be and remain subject to assessments of grantors, regardless whether irrigation water is used thereon."
9. Terms and provisions as contained in Easement from Guy A. Galletti, a single man to the United States of America, dated July 20, 1964, and recorded July 27, 1964, in Volume 355 page 18, Deed records of Klamath County, Oregon.
10. Except reservations, restrictions, rights-of-way, easements of record and those apparent upon the land.
