11 THIS MATTER came before the hearings officer James J. Spindor  
12 for hearing on August 15, 1985. The hearings officer heard testimony  
13 from the applicants and several witnesses, as well as several witnesses  
14 in opposition to the matter.

15 The above matter is hereby continued for a period of 45 days  
16 from the date of this order, or until such time as the applicants present  
17 a report to the Klamath County Planning Department, whichever is sooner,  
18 by an expert showing the affect which the construction of the church and  
19 parking lot as proposed will have with regard to: (1) run-off of water  
20 on adjoining property; and (2) the high water table in the area and pos-  
21 sible affects on adjoining property owners.

22 This order of continuance is based on the following findings  
23 of fact:

- 24 1. Prior hearings with regard to this matter were heard on  
25 December 6, 1984 and January 3, 1985, and an order of continuance was  
26 signed on January 17, 1985, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit  
"A" and by reference incorporated herein.
2. At the January 3, 1985 hearing, the applicants stated

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1 that a Doug Adkins was employed to study the run-off and possible high  
2 water problems.

3       3. At the above mentioned hearing of August 15, 1985, no plan  
4 or expert testimony was presented as to potential run-off problems or  
5 high water problems. However, the applicants stated that these would not  
6 be problems and certain neighbors stated that these would or could be  
7 problems.

8       4. The hearings officer needs some expert testimony setting  
9 forth what affect the construction of the church and parking lot as pro-  
10 posed will have with regard to run-off of water unto adjoining property  
11 as well as the possible affect of the high water table in this area on  
12 the adjoining property.

13       NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled  
14 matter be, and hereby is, continued for a period of 45 days until such  
15 time as the applicant presents a report as set forth hereinabove, which-  
16 ever is sooner.
