CONSENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS the United States of America, hereinafter called the Government, has an interest in the real property hereinafter described by virtue of right-of-way easement deeds dated 17 January 1967, and recorded 25 August 1967; in Volume M-67, page 6671; dated 3 August 1967, and recorded 30 August 1967; in Volume M-67, page 6666; dated 28 March 1969, and recorded 12 May 1969 in Volume M-69, page 3543; and dated 4 April 1969, and recorded 12 May 1969 in Volume M-69, page 3538 in the records of Klamath County, Oregon, and which easements traverse the following described real property in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon to wit:

E1/2E1/2 Section 21, Township 36 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

WHEREAS, Pacific Power and Light Company, hereinafter called the Company, has need to construct, operate, and maintain a 12 KV overhead powerline and the necessary appurtenances thereto within the Government's easement.

NOW THEREFORE, the Government consents to the construction, operation, and maintenance of said powerline and appurtenances thereto within the Government's easement, subject to the following conditions.

1. Construction will be in accordance with construction drawings submitted to and on file with the Government in Klamath Falls, OR.
2. The Company shall repair all damage to National Forest roads caused by the Company in the construction, operation, and maintenance of said powerline and appurtenances.
3. This agreement is executed with the express understanding that should future reconstruction or maintenance of Government's road require the relocation of the Company's powerline and appurtenances, such relocation will be done by the Company at its expense within sixty (60) days following a written request to relocate.
4. The Company shall indemnify and hold harmless the Government against all claims or liabilities for damage to life or property arising from the Company's acts or omissions in the construction, operation, and maintenance of said powerline and appurtenances.
5. This Consent Agreement is issued on the condition that the Company has secured, or will secure, the consent of any person having claim to the land.

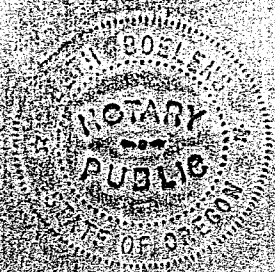
