2. The bond of the trustee shall be the blanket bond heretofore approved and filed with the Clerk of the U. S. Bankruptcy Court.

3. THE DEBTOR(S) SHALL FILE, WITHIN 10 DAYS, TRIPPLICATE ORIGINALS OF: the appropriate Chapter 7 Statement of Affairs, complete A and B schedules listing all creditors and property of the debtor(s) as of the date of conversion to Chapter 7, AND a mailing matrix consisting of the names and addresses of all creditors whose debts were incurred after filing of the Chapter 13 petition and before the date of conversion, with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court unless already filed prior to this order.

4. Upon filing a final report the Chapter 13 trustee shall be discharged and relieved of his trust, the trustee's bond cancelled and any sureties thereon released from further liability thereunder, except for any liability which may have accrued while such bond was in effect.

5. ANY ORDER DIRECTING EMPLOYER TO PAY WAGES TO TRUSTEE PREVIOUSLY ENTERED HEREIN IS NOW TERMINATED AND the employer of the debtor should therefore discontinue making payments to the trustee and should hereafter pay all net wages earned by the debtor directly to the debtor.
