Notice of Location of Placer Claim

STATE of OREGON, County of Klamath

Mining District.

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That the undersigned locators, each a citizen of the United States or one who has declared his intention to become such, have discovered a placer deposit of locatable minerals upon the public domain of the United States which is open to mineral entry and location within the above state, county and mining district; and, in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon, have located and hereby do locate a placer claim of 160 acres by posting this notice of location on a post or monument in a conspicuous place inside the boundaries of the claim. The claim is named the Southern Grace Survey #2 (two) Claim, which is described as follows (fill out one of the two sections below):

The distance between posts may not exceed 1320 feet. The number of posts will vary depending on the size of the claim.

The location of this claim is distinctly marked on the ground so that the boundaries of the claim may be readily traced: Starting at the Northwest corner of Section 1 (one), T. 33. South, Range 6 East (of the Willamette Meridian) (it being a surveyed corner) thence in a

Northerly direction 5280 feet, more or less, to the beginning point of the description of the placer claim hereby located, to-wit: a substantial post set in the ground, marked Post No. 1;

thence 1320 feet in a Northerly direction to a post marked No. 2;

thence 1320 feet in a Northerly direction to a post marked No. 3;

thence 1320 feet in a Easterly direction to a post marked No. 4;

thence 550 feet in a Easterly direction to post #4 (at the border of the National Park);

thence 1185 feet in a Southeasterly direction to a post marked No. 5 (at the corner of the Park);

thence 395 feet in a Southerly direction to a post marked No. 6;

thence 1320 feet in a Southerly direction to a post marked No. 7;

thence 1320 feet in a Westerly direction to a post marked No. 8;

thence 1320 feet in a Westerly direction to the post marked No. 1.

This claim is situated in the Southwest (quarter section) of Section 25 (Twenty-Five) Township, 32 South, Range 6 East, of the Willamette Meridian, either as surveyed by the U.S. Government or protracted if the land is unsurveyed.

The locators intend to hold and work the above described claim as provided by the laws of the United States and the State of Oregon and claim all of the rights and privileges granted by existing laws and customs. In construing this location notice, the singular includes the plural and vice versa if the context so requires.
