3 A hearing was held on this matter on September 5, 1985, pur-  
 4 suant to notice given in conformity with Ordinance No. 45.2,  
 5 Klamath County, before the Klamath County Hearings Officer, Brad  
 6 Aspell. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented  
 7 by Claudia Stine. The Hearings Reporter was Janet Libercajt.

8 This order is based on the following findings of fact:  
 9

FINDINGS OF FACT:

10 1. The property occupant, Stanley Williams, appeared and  
 11 acknowledged that clearing of scrap metal and salvage from his  
 12 property has begun as per Hearings Officer order dated July 1,  
 13 1985. Mr. Williams stated that he had made arrangements with  
 14 Sessler Inc. to have remaining scrap metal and salvage removed  
 15 from his property, and that a period of 10 to 14 days was suffi-  
 16 cient time to complete clean-up.

17 The Hearings Officer, based on the foregoing Findings of  
 18 Fact, accordingly orders as follows:

19 That real property described as

20 "being generally located at 8012 Homedale Road, about  
 21 500 feet north of Henley Road, and more particularly  
 22 described as being located in Tax Lot 200, located in  
 the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 26, Township 39, Range 9,  
 Klamath County, Oregon,"

23 is to be cleared of all scrap metal and salvage and to have said  
 24 property in a clean and orderly condition on or before September  
 25 19, 1985, at 1:30 p.m.
